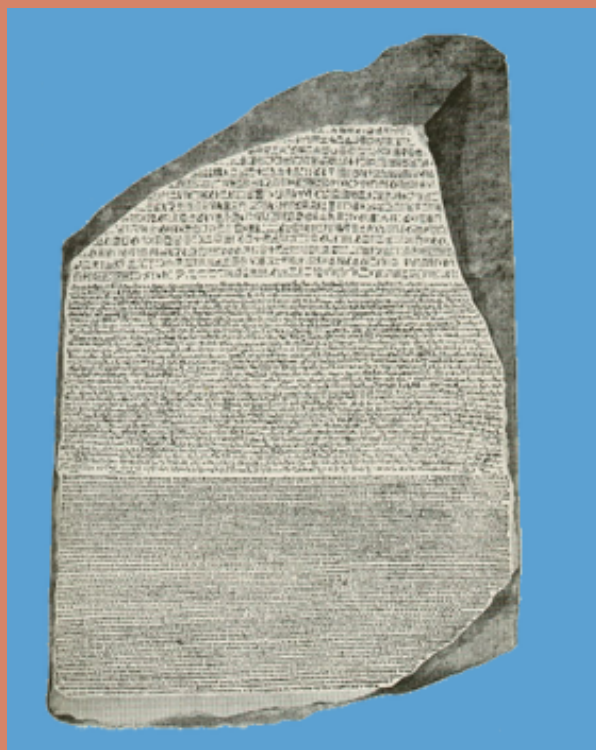


Hieroglyphics

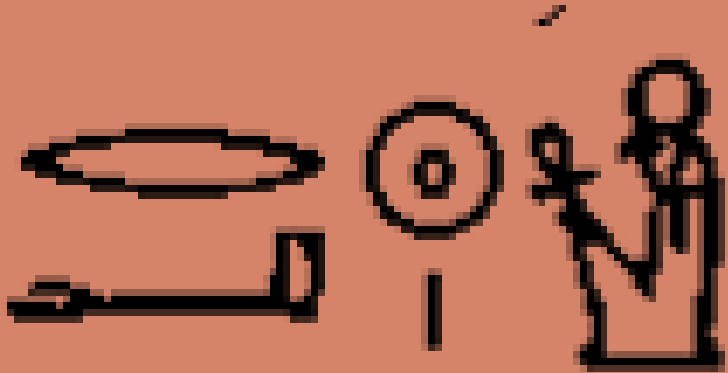
From studying Hieroglyphics we have learned about ancient civilizations, their beliefs, culture and traditions. It laid the foundation for many modern writing systems used today.



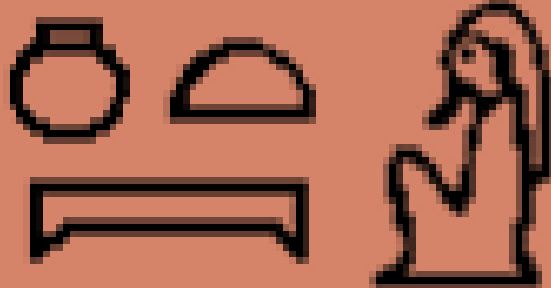
Ancient Egyptians worshipped over 2000 gods and goddesses. Some of them looked like humans while others were part human and part animal..

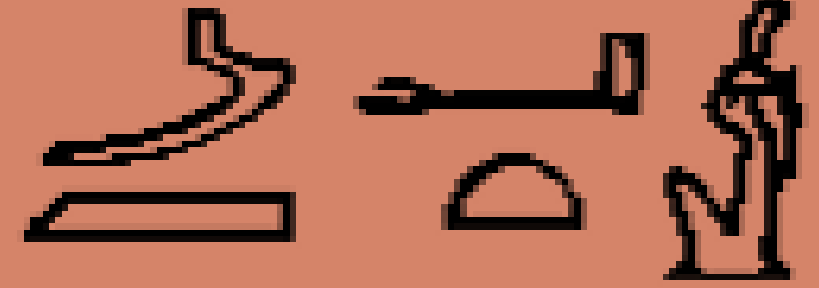
Ra, god of the sun

Ma'at, goddess of truth and justice



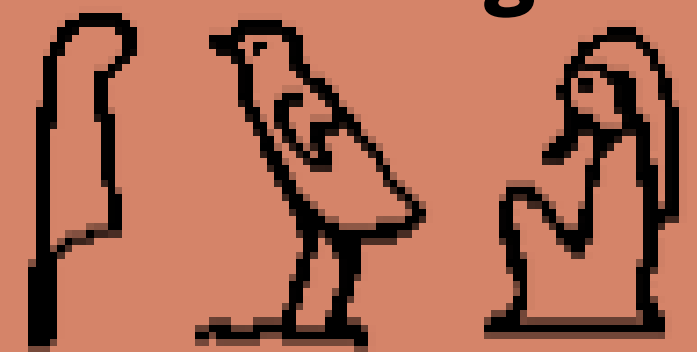
Thoth, god of writing and knowledge



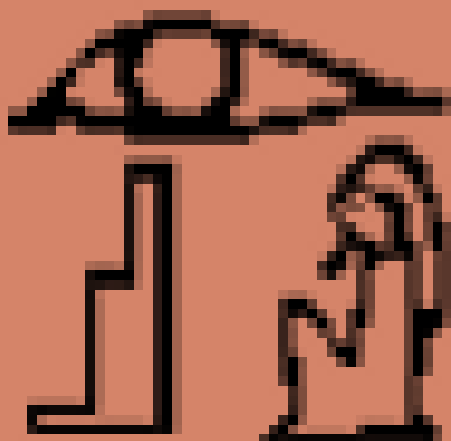
Sobek, god of the Nile



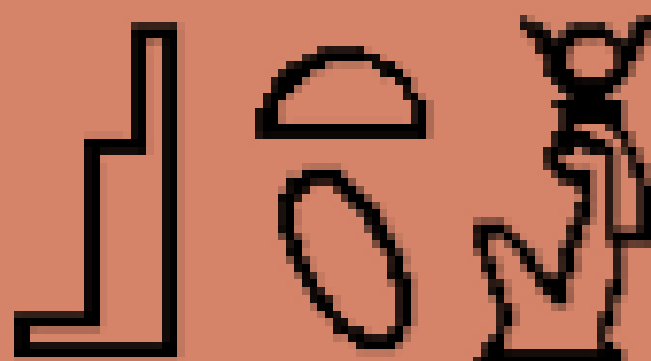
Shu, god of the air and sunlight



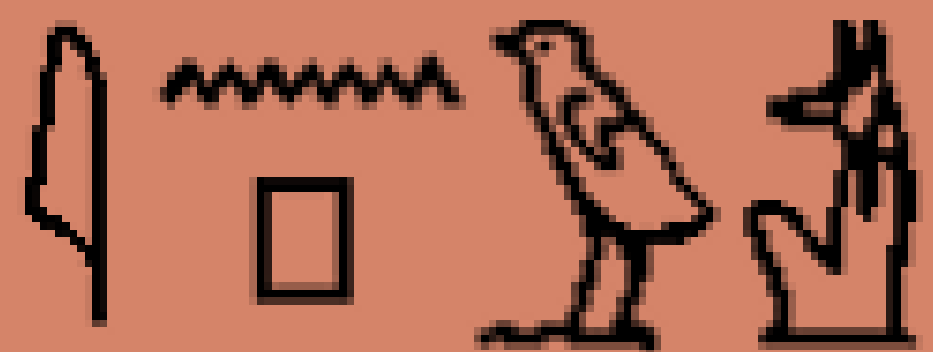
Osiris, a vegetation god



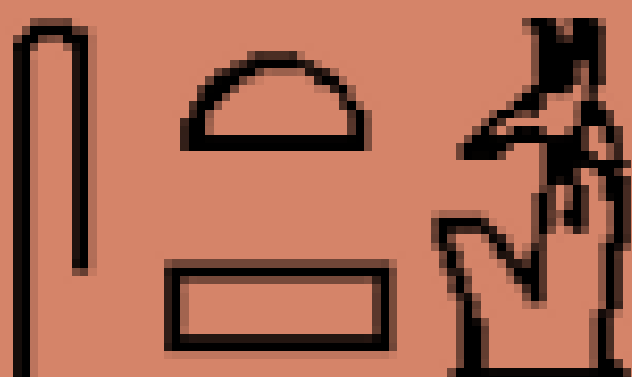
Isis, goddess of the Moon
